

THE EAST COAST RUN a celebration & history

The East Coast Run is one of the most prestigious annual events in the vintage vehicle calendar. This presentation in a 2-disc set celebrates several of the runs up to 2006, and was released in the 40th anniversary year. The ECR attracts preserved classic road transport of all genres, from buses and cars, through to fire engines, trucks, vans & motorcycles.

DISK ONE : 68 mins : Captured on archive film, we see part of the 1991 and the full rally which was the run's Silver Jubilee Year in 1993. The route then was via Beverley & Driffield, and was attended by approximately 300 vehicles. This first disc also includes a ride on an AEC Bridgemaster of EYMS.

DISK TWO : 98 mins : East Coast Runs, 2003, 2004, 2006. The new route was now the 'Brid Low Road' via the A165 and both Skirlaugh and Beeford, entering Bridlington down Kingsgate and on to Sewerby Fields. The Disc also includes a brief visit to the Humber Car Museum and the world's collection of working Humber's owned by Alan Marshall. We also meet Peter Shipp, CEO of EYMS Ltd, a company that have supported the run and bus preservation movement in general, as he takes us for a nostalgic drive in the preserved EYMS Bedford OB and shows us some historic company photographs.

East Yorkshire Thoroughbred Car Club's THE 40th EAST COAST RUN

Organised by the East Yorkshire Thoroughbred Car Club, the 40th East Coast Run in 2008 departed Hull's East Park to run via the A165 to Bridlington and on to Sewerby Fields for one of the biggest classic vehicle rallies in the north of England.



There were over 500 classic vehicles of all kinds at this 40th anniversary event, buses, cars, fire engines, vans, motorcycles and lorries and some military, all gathered in East Park for the 11am departure. The huge cavalcade made its way via Skirlaugh and Beeford to Bridlington's Sewerby Fields, arriving at 12 noon.

This film also includes rides in a Jaguar MkII, and a Humber Sceptre MkIII. In keeping with the historic mood of the rally as a whole, the event also featured a 1960's Fashion Parade hosted by Diana Hudson.



We also join in the competitive spirit of these rallies for the presentation of the trophies to the winners of their various classes by Richard Boyes, Chairman of the East Yorkshire Thoroughbred Car Club.
